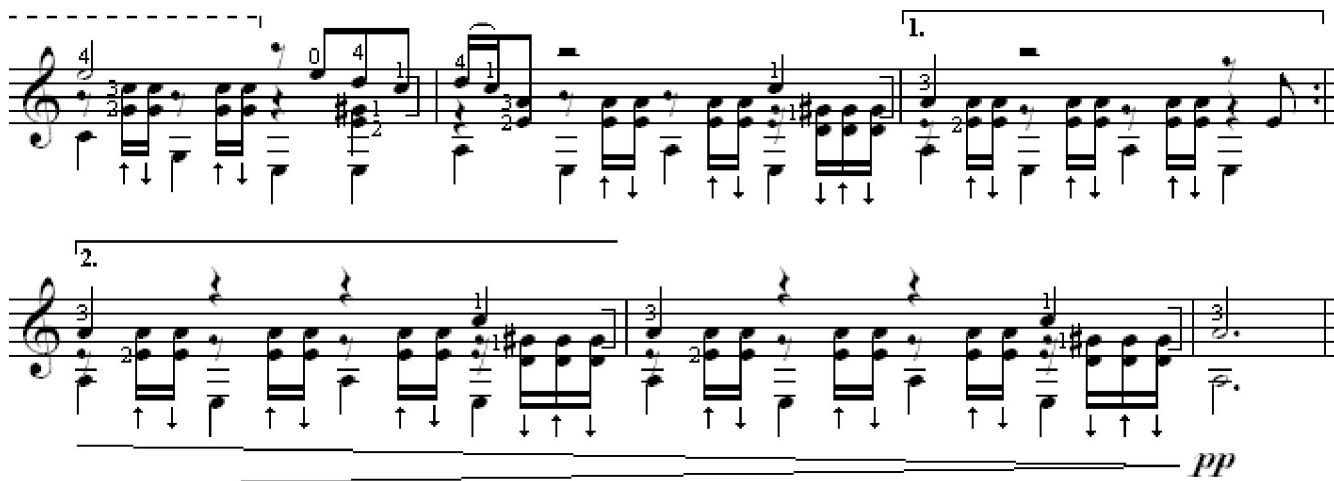


EL CONDOR PASA

*) ↑ – Stroke with the OUTER SIDE of the right hand fingers (for three strings it is more convenient to use 3 fingers – index, middle and ring; and for two strings to use 2 fingers – index and middle or middle and ring).

↓ – Stroke with the INNER SIDE of the right hand fingers (number of used fingers, again, corresponds to the number of strings).

Please note, that with the stroke, that, in fact, is an element of “beat”, only the notes that are ON THE SAME vertical line with arrows are performed (these notes are always taken on adjacent strings, that makes their performance very convenient by this way). Other notes, not indicated by arrows, are executed in the usual method which is characteristic to the classical guitar.
