Take the time to play the main melody in isolation so you can carefully carve out each phrase. Play it as many times as you need so that when you add in the right-hand arpeggios and the left hand barres you still maintain the integrity of this evergreen classic.

One of the many challenges in this work is to keep the melody connected while using the barre technique. Recording yourself will be a useful way to listen critically to your legato technique so that you can improve and eventually master this wonderful work.
